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## **Illustrator Instructions – Please Read!!**

**PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING YOUR ILLUSTRATIONS! Have your parent/guardian review this paper with you. THANK YOU!**

1. **PROOFREAD** – Proofread your (1) story and (2) About the Author page (if included). Mark any errors (typos, misspellings, etc.) and return those pages to the Publishing Center for correction. **Do not illustrate a page that has errors on it. Return it to us clearly marked as needing correction.** We will make the correction(s) and send new pages to you for illustration. *Parents - Keep in mind that the story has already been edited by the teacher in a manner acceptable for the grade level – please resist the urge to rewrite your child’s story.*
2. **PAGE ILLUSTRATION** – Illustrate your story pages. We have included colored pencils for you to use, but if you would prefer to use crayons, you may. **NOTE: Do not draw anything within one inch of the LEFT margin - it will be covered up in the binding process.**
3. **FRONT COVER** – Illustrate your front cover (the white covered board). **IMPORTANT: (1) Do not draw anything within one inch of the LEFT margin – it will be covered up in the binding process, and (2) DO NOT WRITE THE TITLE OF THE BOOK OR YOUR NAME ON THE COVER.**
4. **CLEAN UP & RETURN** – Place your (1) illustrated pages, (2) cover, and (3) colored pencils back in the envelope and return it to the Publishing Center by the date indicated above. Please sharpen the pencils before returning. We cannot complete your book until all items are returned!
